SUMMARY: Provide comprehensive reproductive health care to clients in accordance with DPH guidelines and SWCAP Neighborhood Health Partners protocols.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES: include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

Perform physical assessments and preventative health measures in accordance with TitleX, ACOG, DPH Family Planning/Sexual Health and Early Intervention Guidelines and best practice guidelines.

Order, interpret and evaluate diagnostic tests to identify and assess client clinic problems and health care needs.

Record physical problems and formulate plan based on client condition.

Maintain and or supervise follow up of abnormal lab reports and physical findings including abnormal pap log.

Discuss abnormal findings with client's primary health provider or with the medical director as necessary to prepare a comprehensive care plan.

Prescribe or recommend medication or other forms of treatment as needed.

Refer clients to physician for consultation or to specialized resources for treatment as needed.

Provide reproductive health information to clients and staff.

Identify and monitor clients with risk factors.

Act with program director as a liaison with the medical community.

Keep abreast of professional developments and knowledge in the reproductive health field.

Attend conferences relevant to job responsibilities.

Participate in the in-service education of program staff as needed.

Actively participate in staff meetings and participate on committees as needed.

Update protocols, procedures and fact sheets on a regular basis.

Responsible for OSHA and MSDS and prepare yearly staff trainings in conjunction with the Clinical Assistant 2.

Assume coordination for or participate in special projects or research.

Maintain an up-to-date inventory on equipment.

Maintain relationships with area health care and social service providers and pursue improved ways of coordinating services.

Prepares clinic data reports for program director.

Other duties as assigned.
