

To determine if your household income is 80% or below your county median:

1. Use the table, below.
2. Find the column for the county where you live.
3. Go down the rows in that column until you find the number of people that live in your household.
4. The number in that cell is 80% of the monthly median household income for your county.
5. If your monthly household income equals this number or is less than this number, you are income eligible for Wisconsin Emergency Rental Assistance. Other factors may influence your eligibility.

For example:

1. Let's say you live in Platteville in Grant County, and four people live in your household.
2. Find the column that says, "Grant County."
3. Find the row that says, "Household Size." "4."
4. The number in the cell at the intersection of "4" and "Grant County" is \$4,721. \$4,721 is 80% of the median household income in Grant County.
5. If your monthly income is \$4,721 or less, you are income eligible for Wisconsin Emergency Rental Assistance. Other factors may influence your eligibility.
