

Eligibility Criteria for Opportunity House  
Program Participants

\*\*To be eligible for services, applicants must meet all of the following criteria. *Eligibility* does not mean that the applicant has been “accepted” into the Opportunity House. Additional considerations apply, including but not limited to space at the house and evaluation by the Program Director that the applicant will be a good fit with other program participants.

Applicant completed 40 days of recovery (zero substance use) or a minimum of 30 days in recovery plus 2 treatment recommendations (number of days in recovery\_\_\_\_\_)

Applicant has been assessed by Unified or other AODA agency (date completed\_\_\_\_\_)

A treatment plan has been established (e.g., IOP, drug court, and so on)
